



Regioni & Città - A "boy from Crotona" commands the most luxurious cruise ship in the world

Crotona - 25 ott 2023 (Prima Notizia 24) Seven Seas Grandeur will be the name of Regent Seven Seas Cruises' next flagship, scheduled for delivery next November 2023.

"While our new ships are always highly anticipated Seven Seas Grandeur has proven to be so popular, we had to create an additional sailing for her inaugural season," said Andrea DeMarco, President of Regent Seven Seas Cruises. Captain Luciano Montesanto was born and raised in Crotona, Calabria, which is where, as soon as he can, he returns to find "my family, my childhood, my identity". For over 20 years he has been at sea, and the sea is his real life. After completing his studies and his period of theoretical and practical training at the Nautical Institute of Crotona, at the age of 19 he began to sail around the world. First, as a cadet for an oil tanker shipping company. Then, in 2002, after obtaining his officer's license, his interests changed, and he preferred to opt for the cruise ships industries. This will not only allow him to travel all over the world, and to get to know countries and nations that he could never have imagined seeing as a boy, but also allows him to participate directly and personally in the most delicate phase of the construction of a ship, directly on the shipyards to provide together with his team any suggestions to the technicians who work on the details. It was in 2022 that Captain Luciano Montesanto was promoted to Master of the Seven Seas Splendor and in 2023 appointed to be the Master of the Seven Seas Grandeur "It is an immense privilege to have been appointed Master of a brand new ship like this, and to be part of this incredible team of professionals colleagues. As an Italian, I must admit, I am also very proud of the fact that the ship was entirely built in my home country and it will be an honor to share the Made in Italy craftsmanship all over the world". With 548 crew members, 373 different suites, complete with a balcony overlooking the sea, 10 different meeting places, Seven Seas Grandeur will be able to accommodate at least 746 passengers and will boast a gross tonnage of 55,500 tons, providing – assure the Fincantieri technicians who built it – one of the highest public spaces and crew ratios in the sector. It is practically the sister ship of Seven Seas Explorer, along with

the Seven Seas Splendor. Regent Seven Seas cruises is the world's leading luxury cruise line, offering an unrivaled experience for over 30 years. Seven Seas Explorer, Seven Seas Mariner, Seven Seas Navigator, Seven Seas Splendor, Seven Seas Voyager and from 2023 Seven Seas Grandeur - form the most luxurious fleet in the world, ships that call at over 500 different destinations around the world every year.
